This course is intended to train members to be instructors for the AUXSC&E Course. It is a demanding five day class, which includes a final written examination and a practical, on a navigation chart, examination. In addition to the eight hours of daily classroom training, several hours (3-5) are required for reading of reference material and study prior to each daily class. In addition to classroom training and reading there is an entire day of plotting on a navigation chart. The final practical exam also requires plotting under the pressure of limited time. Because of the intensity of the classroom training and the quantity of plotting on a navigation chart, students must be currently proficient in navigation and plotting skills and be physically prepared to plot continuously for several hours.

I meet the following prerequisites for this class:

1. I am qualified as an Auxiliary Instructor and current in my qualification.
2. I am qualified in the Auxiliary as Coxswain, Boat Crew, Pilot (at any level) or Air Crew, and current in my qualification.
3. I have successfully completed the AUXNAV course.
